Steele Memorial Medical Center held its annual flu vaccination clinic on Saturday September 27, 2008 at Steele Memorial Clinic with 384 shots administered. The program went smoothly with the largest number of vaccinations given during the first hour-and-a-half. The vaccinations were administered by 12 staff members from 8:00 a.m. to noon. Previous clinics here have seen anywhere from 300 to 500 shots given.
